# Staff week - Promoting inclusion and intercultural dialogue in international environments

Interested in inclusion and intercultural dialogue in Higher Education? Join the Alcalá staff week! **Register until 15 January 2024!** 



EUGLOH is arranging a **Staff Week addressing the specific needs of migrants, refugees, minority groups, and indigenous communities**. The activity focuses on identifying best practice for university initiatives that (i) raise awareness about global health issues in these groups and (ii) enhance intercultural dialogue, that are tailored to suit the ever more diverse and multilingual nature of local and regional ecosystems.

A key feature of this activity is the 'train the trainer' approach, which includes active participation and co-design with representatives from the communities it aims to serve. This ensures that the training is inclusive, culturally sensitive, and directly addresses the specific needs of these communities. A detailed description of the Staff Week and its background ensues.

The main objectives of this activity are the presentation of flagships by partners, the identification of new initiatives that may be brought by the participants, the draft of a catalogue of best practice, the set-up of replication and extrapolation of flagships. The special needs of migrant/minority/indigenous communities will be addressed, and representatives of these communities will be involved in the co-designing process.

#### Structure and learning outcomes

The Staff Week will be held onsite at the University of Alcalá. Hybrid participation will be made possible to encourage the virtual presence of NGO, associations and other organisations which collaborate with partner universities. A virtual space will be opened during the whole month of April and beyond so that participants in the Staff Week can be in touch, engage in relevant discussion, and post contributions in different formats (links, texts, videos, etc.).

#### The following outcomes are aimed at:

- Identify relevant topics by mapping the needs of the target group.
- Collect best practice/initiatives within the different institutions.
- Contribute with knowledge and expertise in relation to the topics of WP6 and T6.3.
- Explore the replication and extrapolation of initiatives into our own contexts.
- Engage in intercultural dialogue to co-design contents.
- Join efforts to build an observatory and platform for the development of intercultural competencies in our institutions.
