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Summer School in person at the University of Hamburg!

Universität Hamburg announces the Summer School in Health Economics implemented by the Hamburg Center for Health Economics at Universität Hamburg. The 2-week program will take place from **15 July – 26 July 2024**.

What does UniHamburg offer?

- → 2-week program in Hamburg
- → Up to 6 credits (ECTS)
- → Program fee: EUR 1250 (fee is waived for students of the EUGLOH network)
- → Fees include: Health Economics course (including course material, official certificate, get-together, and much more)

For students from our EUGLOH network, UH offers three full fee waivers and will cover travel and accommodation costs. The funding comes from a national program (DAAD), flanking the EU-initiative. Travel and accommodation grants will be handled by the local EUGLOH team at Universität Hamburg.

If more than three students from the EUGLOH network apply for the summer program, the selection committee will decide about who will receive the full fee waivers.

Call for guest speakers! - Webinar on chronic pain


U.Porto is developing a **Webinar on Chronic Pain** as an Extra Activity in the **2nd** semester of **2024**.

Student success: from USZ to UPS!

András Nagy, a medical student in his 5th year was the first student from the Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical School to spend a whole semester at the Paris-Saclay University with Erasmus+

Please read his testimonial below.

"As a 5th year student, I attended the medical school of the Paris-Saclay University between August 2023 and February 2024. My time there was funded by an Erasmus+ scholarship. The application period was not as smooth as I hoped to be, as it was difficult to find courses overlapping with the requirements in Hungary. The French has a different system for the last 3 years of medical school: their curriculum is built on the system of bulks. They are attending lectures for 6 weeks, then they have a week for taking their exams of the attended courses (mostly simple or multiple choice tasks or short essays, all done on tablets).

In the next bulk, they work in hospitals as **interns** for 7 weeks. They spend the whole internship in the same ward, and they receive a salary for the work (approximately €400). Students on Erasmus scholarship are also eligible for that salary. Even a French bank account is not necessary for it. The language of the training was French, but my B1 level was completely enough for understanding everything. The University provides a free language course for 1 semester, and you can continue learning for €50/semester. Unfortunately, the University couldn't help me finding an accommodation, but I managed to book a room at an acceptable price through a realtor. In general, administration was pretty problematic. On many occasions, the responsible person was on holiday or I needed to wait a long time to get things done.

The best part was the company of my fellow Erasmus students. There were approximately 30 of us at the faculty. The French students organized targeted events for us, but we also visited their own vents as well, where they greeted us cordially. Not to mention that, in Paris, you could always find a program that is either free or not so expensive for people under 26 years (most of the museums don't have an entry fee, if you're younger than 26). There was one special company I would like to mention: Erasmus Place. They organize cheaper bus tours, picnics, and parties specifically for Erasmus students. I travelled with them to the Loire valley, to Mont Saint-Michel, and to the Champagne Region). I was always satisfied.

I am the first medical student from the University of Szeged who spent a whole semester at the Paris-Saclay University and in total, I would recommend the experience to anyone who speaks at least a little bit of French, and who are open to discover a true metropolis. Despite the difficulties, it was worth it as I have many new experiences and new friends."
