Students, this is your chance to participate in a **Summer School in Paris!** 😊



👉 **Tore Godal** is the keynote speaker at the event. He is **Norway's leading health diplomat** and internationally recognized for organizing groundbreaking vaccination campaigns in the global south to prevent the spread of tropical diseases and pandemics.

Godal will draw on his own career to demonstrate how research conducted in broad networks, both in the North and South, can yield good results for handling global health challenges.

For such a reason, he is referred to by NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg as "surely, after Fridtjof Nansen, the Norwegian who has saved the most lives in the world." Godal's career is also described in a recently published book by Conrad Keating, who will also participate in the webinar.

The webinar is open to all students and staff at UiT and is intended to stimulate effective research-to-action initiatives both globally and locally.

I think it can be of interest for many students and employees out there in the EUGLOH Alliance who would like to know more about how it is possible, in concrete steps, to building health institutions globally, via networks across the scientific and political sphere.

A colleague from Porto in Szeged

Let's read the account of Marco Gabriel, participating in an Erasmus exchange in Szeged! 😊

SZEGED - Where the sun always shines

"In an exciting initiative of international collaboration, I embarked on a journey of **learning and cultural exchange at the University of Szeged**. Szeged, a historic city in southern Hungary, is known for its impressive architecture.

This 5-day stay, as part of the **prestigious Erasmus+ Programme**, highlighted the importance of involving non-teaching staff in international mobility initiatives, thus promoting **personal and professional enrichment** in a global context. The Erasmus+ Programme aims to strengthen academic links between higher education institutions, as well as recognising the vital role played by technical staff in the effective operation of universities. This stay provided me with a unique opportunity to share knowledge as well as **improve practice** in social exchange, while exploring the cultural nuances and working methodologies of the University and Cultural Institutions of Szeged.

During my stay, I took part in a range of activities, including guided tours and interactions with members of the academic and local community. I was able to absorb other professional skills and immerse myself in the city's vast cultural heritage, providing an enriching and multifaceted experience. It is therefore important to highlight the key points of this visit:

- Móra Ferenc Museum: A museum dedicated to the history and culture of the region, with varied exhibitions.
 - Szeged Cathedral (Szegedi Dóm): An impressive neo-Romanesque church with its tall tower and stained glass windows standing out.
 - Bridges over the River Tisza: Szeged is crossed by the River Tisza and its bridges offer breathtaking views of the city and the river.
 - Votive Church: A majestic neo-Gothic style church that dominates the Szeged skyline.
 - REÖK: Szeged's Art Gallery which exhibits collections of works by local and international artists.
 - AGORA Cultural Szeged: Dynamic cultural centre offering cultural activities and events for city residents and visitors (exhibitions, theatre, music, lectures).
 - Szeged National Theatre: Located in an impressive building, it is known for its grandiose architecture and its importance as a cultural centre in southern Hungary.
- 👉 This initiative not only strengthened relations between the two institutions, but also reinforced the University of Porto's commitment to excellence and internationalisation. By investing in the professional development of their technical teams through the Erasmus+ Programme, universities are promoting a culture of exchange and continuous learning in order to define strategies that enable their staff to face the challenges and opportunities of an increasingly global world."
