

## LONG TALK SESSION

Please read the following instructions for the long talk sessions:

Presentations in long talk sessions should be no longer than 20 minutes, leaving 10 minutes for discussion. Aim of the long presentations is to demonstrate and discuss research with results. Presentation and the slides should be in English.

In case of long talk sessions, authors may submit a full paper as well, which will be assigned to discussants (to the session chair and one of the presenters in the session). The complete paper should be written in English in accordance with the abstract accepted. There are no requirements related to the form of the paper.

## SHORT TALK SESSION

Please read the following instructions for the short talk sessions:

Presentations in short talk sessions should be no longer than 10 minutes, leaving 5 minutes for discussion. Please be very strict in terms of time managements! Aim of the short presentations is to propose research ideas, concepts and preliminary results. Presentation and the slides should be in English. In case of short talk sessions, there is no need to submit a full paper, which would be reviewed by a discussant.
