In order to take part in the Faculty Round, participants are expected to hand in and deliver a presentation in front of an audience. The Faculty Jury evaluates their achievement.

Procedure of the Faculty Round:

- Deadline for registration: 12:00 am 19 October 2015
- The topics to be presented are chosen by the Faculty Jury, from the articles available in the Scientific Publications Series of the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration (<u>http://www.eco.u-</u> <u>szeged.hu/english/research/scientific-publications/scientific-publications</u>)
- The chosen topic will be sent to each participant via email at 8:00 am on 29 October 2015.
- The presentation has to be prepared on 29 October 2015 between 8:00-14:00, at any location.
- The presentations should be 10 minutes long.
- Participants with a research project of their own
 - will receive a presentation topic close to their research topic
 - have to present their own research results besides elaborating the received topic
 - o have to give their exact research topic at registration
