



APPLICATION PROCEDURE OF STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP OF EXCELLENCE OF MNB September 2021

1. History

As part of its social responsibility strategy the Hungarian National Bank (hereinafter referred to as 'MNB') actively supports valuable contributions to the field of economics by awarding the 'Student Scholarship of Excellence' ('the scholarship'). Within the framework of the MNB Scholarship of Excellence and based on the Scholarship Agreement between the MNB and the University of Szeged (hereinafter referred to as 'SZTE'), the MNB wishes to support 30 students in the BA level programme and 4 students in the MA programme.

The maximum amount of scholarship contributions in the 2021/2022 academic year: 34 students x 50.000 HUF/month x 10 months: 17 000 000 HUF.

2. Application

In order to distribute the available scholarship funds the SZTE will open the application period for its students and will advertise it on its internal forums in accordance with the factors agreed upon in the Scholarship Agreement between the MNB and the SZTE.

To be submitted online at https://modulo.etr.u-szeged.hu not later than 12.00 (noon), 08 October 2021. It is not possible to submit any corrections after the deadline has passed.

Documents to be submitted:

- a) Application Form and Statements;
- b) All official instruments, documents or certificates that the applicant may wish to be considered in the application process.

3. Terms and conditions of application:

Based on the Scholarship Agreement between the MNB and the SZTE, successful applicants shall fulfil the following criteria:

The applicant is a full-time, active, undergraduate BA student in a state-funded or fee-paying form of education at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration of the University of Szeged studying either Business Administration and Management or Finances and Accounting or International Economy and Business or Finance; The applicant is a full-time, active, graduate MA student in a state-funded or fee-paying form of education at the Faculty of Economics and





Business Administration of the University of Szeged studying International Economy and Business; Finance.

- b) The applicant has registered to, at least, two semesters of a bachelor's or master's degree training programme to be aided by the scholarship, and has collected, at least, 54 credit points in the previous two subsequent, active semesters.
- c) The applicant has completed, pro rata temporis, minimum 90% of the total number of credit points as set forth in the Sample Curriculum of the major concerned.
- d) In the previous two subsequent, finished, active semesters, the weighted credit index of the courses the applicant registered for was better than 4.00 in both semesters, and the applicant participated in scientific or other professional activities as well.
- e) The applicant agrees to personally attend the scholarship award conference organized by the MNB.
- f) The applicant is not a Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holder.
- g) The applicant fills and submits the data protection form of the MNB together with the application.

Furthermore, all students who were/will be participating in a mobility programme within the framework of a mobility agreement (e.g. Erasmus+, CEEPUS, CAMPUS Mundi or institutional bilateral agreements), were/will be completing partial training or in-company internship abroad in the two preceding active semesters or during the payment period of the scholarship that form the basis of the calculation of points shall also be regarded as eligible applicants for the scholarship.

4. The evaluation committee

5. Evaluation of the submitted applications







In harmony with the Scholarship Agreement concluded between the University of Szeged and Magyar Nemzeti Bank, the Central Bank of Hungary (MNB), the Jury Committee will apply the following rating criteria in the evaluation process: academic performance (50%); scientific activities, such as publications, scientific student association papers, participation in international and national competitions and special college activities (40%); and public functions and community activities (10%).

The evaluation point system of the Student Scholarship of Excellence of MNB is as follows:

A. Academic Performance (maximum 50 points to be awarded)

Applicants can earn maximum 50 points in the academic performance category. The points are calculated based on the weighted credit index of the courses starting from 4.00. One point is awarded for each 0.2 basis points starting from 4.00. F.e 4.02 weighted credit index worth 1 point; 4.10 worth 5 points; 4.50 worth 25 points.

We expressly reserve the right of withdrawal. A remedy shall not be available against the evaluation of the application or the decision to terminate the scholarship.

6. Notification of Applicants

Deadline of the evaluation of applications and notification of applicants is 10 October 2021. The applicants shall be notified via an electronic mail on the address given in the application form. The decision on the scholarship shall be finalised by MNB.

7. Terms and conditions of eligibility for the scholarship







- a) The scholarship awarded for the Academic Year of 2021/2022 may be paid exclusively in the academic year of 2021/2022 by the University of Szeged. The payment of the scholarship cannot be restructured for later than the academic year following the academic year of application.
- b) If, in line with the timeframe of the training programme, a student finishes her/his studies in an odd semester (i.e. the First or Autumn Semester of the Academic Year of 2021/2022), and the same institution offers a master's degree programme that is also aided by the scholarship programme, the student shall remain eligible for the scholarship provided that, following a successful entrance examination, s/he continues her/his studies in the commencing semester in one of the master's degree training programmes of the same higher education institution that is also aided by the scholarship programme.
- c) In the event of termination or suspension of student status, further payment of the scholarship shall be terminated as well.

If the awarded student loses the entitlement for the scholarship, s/he has to be notified via an electronic mail, and further payment of the scholarship will be terminated.

8. Payment of the scholarship

- a) The awarded students shall sign a declaration of acceptance.
- b) The list of awarded students shall be sent to the Education Directorate of MNB by the University of Szeged by 10 October 2021.
- c) The expected payment deadline of the scholarship for September, October and November 2021 is December 2021. In the subsequent months, the scholarship will be paid in monthly instalments.
- d) The announcement of the Invitation for Applications for the scholarship, the decision process of awarding the scholarship and its payment will be performed in accordance with Section 7 (3) c) and the General Provisions of Annex 8 of the Code on the fees and charges payable by the students of the University of Szeged and the forms of support available to them, in conformity with the special regulations for the scholarship.
