

**Internal scoring system for National Higher Education Scholarship applications  
at the SZTE Faculty of Economics and Business Administration**

Applications will be evaluated based on academic performance during the reference period and professional, public, sporting and other activities carried out during the reference period.  
Reference period: the two semesters of the academic year in which the application is submitted

The following applications will be excluded without substantive evaluation

- a) the grade point average calculated in accordance with point I/1 for the reference period is less than 4.5,
- b) the number of credits completed during the reference period is less than 55.

**I. Studies (total max. 60 points)**

1. Study average: the arithmetic mean of the weighted credit average of two semesters to two decimal places. Only the grades recorded in the Electronic Study System by the exact time of the application's evaluation shall be taken into consideration.

The final score shall be determined as follows:

(average calculated in the above detailed manner - 4,5) \* 100

**max.: 50 points**

2. Points awarded for accredited language exams recorded in the Neptun system.

- C1 complex 5 points
- B2 complex professional 4 points
- B2 complex 3 points
- C1 written or oral 2 points
- B2 written or oral 1 point

**max.: 10 points**

**II. Professional activity (max. 30 points in total)**

1. Research, publication

participation in documented, verified research, presentation at a conference max. 5 points

publication in a scientific journal (at least accepted for publication) max. 5 points

2. OTDK (National Scientific Students' Associations Conference)

- 1st place: 10 points
- 2nd place: 8 points
- 3rd place or special prize: 6 points
- participation without ranking: 4 points

3. Other professional or academic competitions (including faculty TDK) documented and verified participation

- 1st place: max. 5 points
- 2nd place: max. 4 points
- 3rd place or special prize: max. 3 points
- Participation without ranking: max. 2 points

#### 4. Teaching assistant activities

- 3 points/semester for excellent performance
- 2 points/semester for satisfactory performance

### **III. Public, sports and other activities (max. 10 points in total, but no more than 10% of the applicant's total score)**

- documented activity in a student organization max: 5 points
- Certified outstanding sports or cultural activities max: 5 points

### **I. + II. + III. total: max.: 100 points**

In the event of a tie, the score obtained in Part I (Studies) will be decisive. If this is also equal, the grade point average will be decisive.
